## **Subject - UGC QUALITY MANDATE**

Dear Sir,

Please refer to your D.O. letter No. F. 1-1/2018(Secy) dated 4<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

We have perused the above D.O. letter and we very much appreciate the "Quality Mandate" as approved by the Commission in its 532<sup>nd</sup> meeting. As given in the "Quality mandate" having curriculum and delivery methodology that ensure adequate employment/ self employment to at least 50% of pass-out students is the need of the hour. Your guidance about training the students in essential professional and soft skills such as team work, communication skills, leadership skills, time management skills etc, inculcating human values and professional ethics, and the spirit of innovation/entrepreneurship and critical thinking among the students as well as promoting avenues for display of these talents will make the students not only useful members of the society, imbued with good moral and social values but will also make the students employment ready when the graduate from the university.

In pursuance to your ibid D.O. letter we have framed a new education policy for our university. While framing the new education policy we have also kept in mind the Autonomous Status of the university as expounded by Dr. Radhakrishnan in "The Report of The University Education Commission" and also the judgment of 11 Judges bench of Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of T.M.A.Pai Foundation & Ors vs State Of Karnataka & Ors on 31 October, 2002.

With the aim of making the students employment ready for various government and PSUs jobs, the course contents and assessment pattern are in conformity with the syllabus and pattern of examination for various government, banking and PSU jobs. This education policy prepares each student confident of undertaking any competitive examination - be it IAS, RAS,

SSC Banking Services, PSUs, Armed Forces, CPOs or the State Police. Thus, this policy will ensure that a pass-out student does not have to go to any coaching institution to prepare for any such competitive examination.

To fill the gap between industry requirement and university education, our university has established three industrial training units right in the industrial hubs at Neemrana, IMT Manesar and in Sitapura Industrial Area, Jaipur. This will also ensure that the students get education in the industrial environment itself.

The whole world is now a 'Global Village'. As given in the education policy, the blended mode of education will make full use of ICT to access and impart knowledge at global level. We are preparing 'learning outcome-based' curriculum framework, making use of all available material, that will prepare students as they graduate, employment ready at global level.

We have replaced the present day assessment system that focuses on rote learning, with a new system of assessment wherein the assessment of the learner by all stake holders -self assessment by the learner, parents, teacher and the potential employer, are all given due weightage.

Education in Foundation Courses which is to be imparted to all students, irrespective of the level/ type of course taken, will help in transforming the learner into a good human being imbued with moral and ethical values and equipped with adequate communication skills coupled with logical reasoning and analytical powers so that his/ her intellectual ability is not confined to his/ her own field but will be useful in any situation and in any field throughout the life.

We are enclosing herewith a copy of our new education policy. You are requested to peruse the same and give your comments, if any, to enable us to improve it further.
